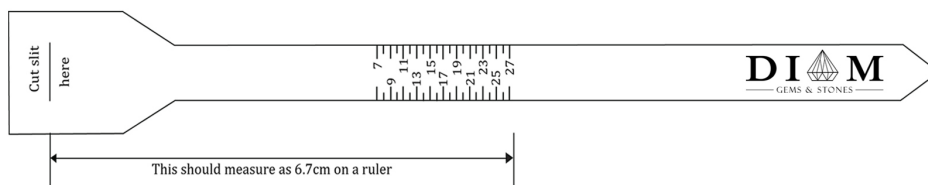


HOW TO DETERMINE YOUR RING SIZE METHOD 1

Please ensure you follow the below instructions carefully as this may result in inaccurate measurements

- STEP ONE When printing this page ensure that 'Page Scaling' is set to 'NONE' or that 'Size Options' is set to 'Actual size' on your print dialog box.
- STEP TWO Cut out the ring sizer shaper below and make a small slit at the left end size as marked.
- STEP THREE Wrap the ring sizer around the finger with the numbers facing out.
- STEP FOUR Insert the pointed end of the ring sizer through the slit.
- STEP FIVE Ensure the ring sizer is placed on the part of your finger where you wish to wear your ring.
- STEP SIX Pull the pointed end of the ring sizer quite tightly to produce a measurement.
- STEP SEVEN The number showing at the slit is the ring measurement of your finger.

HOW TO DETERMINE YOUR RING SIZE METHOD 2

This method should be used to measure the size of an existing ring that fits the finger you wish to wear your ring on perfectly

STEP ONE Choose a ring that you own and that fits the finger you wish to purchase a ring for perfectly.

STEP TWO Put your ring over the circles below and find a match to the inner circle of your ring.

STEP THREE If your ring falls between two sizes than select the larger size as the measurement.
